



**PUBLIC NOTICE**

**MINOR EXEMPTIONS TO THE CITY OF DOLLARD-DES-ORMEAUX'S  
ZONING BY-LAW 82-704**

**NOTICE** is given as follows:

At a regular meeting to be held without public presence on March 8, 2022, at 7:30 p.m., Council will approve requests for minor exemptions to zoning by-law 82-704, in order for the following immovables to comply with the provisions of the *Act Respecting Land Use Planning and Development*:

**Affected immovable**

Building at 100 Montevista Street  
Cadastre No.: 1 763 293  
File No.: DM-151

**Nature of the exemption**

Allow a secondary (west) front setback on Tecumseh Street of 4.27 m (14 ft) instead of the minimum required distance of 4.57 m (15 ft).

**Affected immovable**

Building at 2 Papillon Street  
Cadastre No.: 1 763 285  
File No.: DM-152

**Nature of the exemption**

Allow a right (east) lateral setback of 2,02 m (6.6 ft) instead of the required minimum setback of 2,43 m (8 ft).

In accordance with Ministerial Order 2020-049, any procedure that involves the movement or gathering of citizens, which is part of the decision-making process of the Municipal Council, is replaced with a 15-day written consultation announced beforehand by public notice.
